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Topic

Computers became the dominant and constantly evolving technology of the century we lived in and even everyday life is unthinkable without them. They had many effects of economic, social and education that even new career opportunities are shaped according to these technologies. In parallel with the development of hardware technologies, software technologies are becoming more and more usable for the end user. As it became easier to use, the age of the users decreased, and programming began to be taught even in preschool. In the meantime, the concept of computational thinking (CT) has gradually expanded and delivered through different pedagogical approaches for different age groups. Forming the bases of coding and programming, exploring suitable pedagogical approaches for donating students with CT skills come forth. On the other hand, although pedagogy of programming has been dealt with for some 70 years for higher education, little research exists for teaching coding in the early ages or teaching programming with different tools and approaches. - Coding and Programming Tools
- Teaching-Learning Processes
- Instructional Materials and Tasks
- Teacher Education
- Interdisciplinary Efforts (to integrate CT)

We invite authors to submit first their abstracts and, at a later stage, their full papers on issues related to the above-mentioned topics of pedagogy of teaching programming and computational thinking. Authors can submit research studies, and systematic reviews, as well as idea papers.
